Supporting information for FCC ELS: Dated 6th December 2023

The Ubiquitous Radar has been down selected by US Army for evaluation with the Maneuver Battle Lab at Fort Moore , GA. The evaluation date has been set as 23rd of January 2023.

The Ubiquitous radar is a small, low power man portable radar, developed to provide the warfighter with a quickly deployable Counter UAS detection capability. With an output power of 1W and detection range of 1800ft, the radar has the potential to deliver tactical advantage to the military user.

OFCOM approved within the UK, the Maneuver Battle lab have asked to ensure that the Ubiquitous radar has a FCC STA approval for Transmission at Fort Moore, GA.
