Purpose of Operation The APM-424(V)5 is a critical component designed for flight line testing, specifically intended for the Model 5800 interrogator. The primary purpose of obtaining an FCC license for the APM-424(V)5 is to facilitate intermittent, short-duration checkouts of the Model 5800 interrogator during operational testing at various locations.

The expected usage of the APM-424(V)5 interrogations from the Model 5800 interrogator to a co-located APM-424(V)5 test set. The APM-424(V)5 will receive and respond over-the-air to these interrogations.

This FCC license application aims to ensure regulatory compliance for the utilization of the APM-424(V)5 in these specific testing scenarios, enabling the seamless and efficient evaluation of the Model 5800 interrogator across different locations.

This new application is a renewal, identical to the expired license associated with call sign WO2XON.
