I'm assuming they understand they would be required to schedule all of their testing with both WAFC and AFCAZ at least 7-days prior to turning the equipment on. This can be done via email or phone. There are continuous DoD operations in both the WAFC and AFCAZs areas

of responsibility, so they need to deconflict potential issues.

The IFDS (Integrated Frequency Deconfliction System) inputs are internal to DOD but include technical parameters off the STA request as well as the time frames used. It's a way of deconflicting spectrum use for the DOD. The WAFC will input the data in the system based upon the schedules Caos asks for.
