
Re: **Investigation of Certain 2007 Annual Access Tariffs**  
**WC Docket No. 07-184, WCB/Pricing No. 07-10**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 26, 2007, Sprint Nextel Corporation ("Sprint Nextel") filed a petition to reject the tariff filings of the Broadband Network Group (Transmittal No. 3) and ICORE (Transmittal No. 84) on the grounds that the "safe harbor" language included in those transmittals was incomplete. Specifically, these local exchange carriers ("LECs") committed only to adjust their local switching rates (but not their local transport rates) if and when they met certain refile triggers. On September 28, 2007, both Broadband Network Group (Transmittal No. 4) and ICORE (Transmittal No. 85) amended their tariffs to include the local transport rate adjustment commitment. Because the LECs' September 28 tariff filings address the concerns raised by Sprint Nextel, we withdraw our September 26 Petition to Reject.
