This application is hereby made by Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) for Special Permission to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to make references in NBTC Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Special Access Bundle Service Offer, Contract Offer No. YYY, to the similar contract tariffs of the following AT&T Telephone Companies: Ameritech Operating Companies (Ameritech), Tariff F.C.C. No. 2; and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT), Tariff F.C.C. No. 73 (collectively AT&T Telephone Companies).

With this filing, NBTC is proposing to introduce Contract Offer No. YYY – Special Access Bundle Service Offer, a multi-regional access discount pricing plan, for which concurrent subscription is required to the following Access Tariffs: Ameritech Operating Companies (Ameritech) Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, Contract Offer No. YYY; Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Contract Offer No. YYY; and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) Tariff F.C.C. No. 73, Contract Offer No. YYY. This Contract Offer No. YYY permits Customers that meet the Eligibility Criteria in Section 23.YYY.3, and the Terms and Conditions in Section 23.YYY.4, to purchase Subject Services in Section 23.YYY.2 at the discounted rates listed in Section 23.YYY.5. Subject Services under Contract Offer No. YYY are available in the Pricing Flexibility Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) described in Section 23.YYY.3 (B). Contract Offer No. YYY is available for subscription from October XX, 2007 through November XX, 2007. This Contract Offer is not renewable.
