Under authority of Special Permission No. 08-001 of the Federal Communications Commission, Verizon is submitting tariff pages to introduce a new contract tariff option (Contract Option). This new Contract Option will provide a customer with Billing Credits and other benefits on certain Special Access Services when the customer maintains a minimum in total billed revenue for the services included in the new Contract Option and meets other criteria as specified in the attached tariff pages. This new Contract Option is being filed in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Tariff

F.C.C. No. 11, and Tariff F.C.C. No. 14 where Verizon has received Pricing Flexibility relief for Special Access Services in Qualifying Metropolitan Statistical Areas.
