With this filing CBT proposes to clarify the credit for service interruptions provisions in Section 2 – General Regulations and Section 21 – Wavelength Service. CBT also proposes to introduce a circuit reconnection charge in Section 2 – General Regulations and a new OC-3 Customer Premises Multiplexing rate element in Section 7 – Special Access. CBT also clarifies the Telephone Company access to customer premises nodes language in Section 7 – Special Access and clarifies the Service/Circuit Rearrangement description Section 13 - Additional Engineering, Additional Labor and Miscellaneous Services.
