

## **Description & Justification**

Cincinnati Bell Telephone (CBT) makes this filing pursuant to FCC Special Permission Number 08-006 which waives Sections 61.58 (Notice Requirements) and 61.59 (Effective Period Required Before Changes) of the Commission's Rules.

On February 19, 2008, CBT filed Transmittal No. 825 to become effective on March 5 2008. On the 7<sup>th</sup> Revised Page 19.1 in Transmittal No. 825, CBT sought to add a new rate element for a circuit reconnection charge after the service had been disconnected for non-payment.

CBT respectfully requests permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules to allow CBT to withdraw, without becoming effective, the tariff revisions on the 7<sup>th</sup> Revised Page 19.1 in Transmittal No. 825. CBT wishes to withdraw the proposed revisions in order to allow CBT to further evaluate the reconnection charge rate element.
