The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) hereby amend its Application No. 179, filed on March 10, 2008, in order to remove its request for a waiver of Section 61.58 of the Commission's rules.

Under Application No. 179, Verizon had requested special permission to waive the requirements of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's rules in order to revise material being filed in two separate filings, both planned to be issued March 17, 2008 for effect April 1, 2008.

Subsequent to filing Application No. 179, and following discussions with the Commission staff, Verizon is removing its request for a waiver of Section 61.58 of the Commission's rules. Since both filings planned for March 17, 2008 are going to be made on 15 days' notice, a waiver of Section 61.58 is not required.

Verizon is submitting revised illustrative tariff pages for FCC1 and FCC11 to reflect these changes as well as margin coding changes requested by the Commission staff.

This amended application and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
