This filing, issued under authority of Special Permission No. 08-007, removes regulations, rates and charges specified for the states of Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont. In addition, this filing raises certain End User Common Line/Subscriber Line Charges in Tariff FCC Nos. 1 and 11 following the transfer of certain assets, liabilities and contracts to FairPoint Communications, Inc.²

Also as part of this filing, Verizon is introducing a new Common Channel Signaling Gateway Access Hub location for Verizon New England Inc. in Eastern Massachusetts (LATA 128) to serve LATA 128, LATA 126 (Western Massachusetts) and LATA 130 (Rhode Island).
