With this transmittal, and pursuant to the FCC's Report and Order and Memorandum Opinion and Order, In the Matters of Section 272(f)(1) Sunset of the BOC Separate Affiliate and Related Requirements, WC Docket No. 02-112, 2000 Biennial Regulatory Review Separate Affiliate Requirements of Section 64.1903 of the Commission's Rules, CC Docket No. 00-175, and Petition of AT&T Inc. for Forbearance Under 47 U.S.C. §160(c) with Regard to Certain Dominant Carrier Regulations for In-Region, Interexchange Services, WC Docket No. 06-120, adopted August 30, 2007 and released August 31, 2007, Verizon is canceling its Interstate IntraLATA, Corridor and Long Distance Message Telecommunications Services tariffs.
