With this transmittal, Verizon is submitting tariff pages to introduce a new contract tariff option (Option 51) in its Tariff FCC No. 1. Option 51 provides a customer with discounted monthly rates for DS1 and DS3 ports when the customer transfers such DS1 and DS3 ports from Contract Tariff Option 28 to Option 51. The customer must subscribe to Option 51 and meet the criteria set forth in the attached tariff pages in order to receive the discounted rates. Option 51 is being filed in Tariff FCC No. 1 where Verizon has received Pricing Flexibility relief for Special Access Services in Qualifying Metropolitan Statistical Areas.

In addition, the address of an Issuing Carrier is corrected on Title Page 2.

Supporting material as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is not required with this filing. However, a document with a detailed explanation of the filing is being provided as an attachment hereto.
