With this transmittal, Verizon is submitting tariff pages to:

1. Introduce a new contract tariff option in its Tariff FCC No. 1. This new contract tariff option will provide a discount for customers who order newly installed, full-time Serial Component Video Service or newly installed, High-Definition Digital Video Transport Service in accordance with the criteria specified in the attached tariff pages. This new contract tariff option is being filed in Tariff FCC No. 1 where Verizon has received

Pricing Flexibility relief for Special Access Services in Qualifying Metropolitan Statistical Areas.

Supporting material as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is not required with this portion of the filing. However, a document with a detailed explanation of the filing is being provided as an attachment hereto.

2. Extend the availability of existing IntelliLight<sup>®</sup> Dedicated SONET Ring Service in its Tariff FCC No. 11 until such time as the customer converts to another Verizon service or service from another service provider, until the customer discontinues service, or until Verizon discontinues service. There is no impact to rates as a result of this filing.

Supporting material as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is not required with this portion of the filing.


This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
