## **INTRODUCTION**

The Verizon Telephone Companies are submitting tariff pages to introduce Contract Tariff Option 52 in its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. This Contract Tariff provides an additional discount to the monthly rates of newly installed, full-time Serial Component Video Service (**SCVS**) or newly installed, High-Definition Digital Video Transport Service (**Hi-Def DVTS**) when the customer subscribes to the new contract tariff option and meets the requirements set forth in the attached tariff pages.

This Contract Tariff Option is filed pursuant to Verizon receiving Pricing Flexibility relief for Special Access Services in qualifying Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs)<sup>1</sup>.

## **DESCRIPTION**

This Contract Tariff is specifically designed for customers who order a minimum of three (3) full-time, SCVS channels or a minimum of three (3) Hi-Def DVTS channels during the subscription period which ends March 31, 2009. When the requirements of this contract tariff option are met, the customer will receive an additional discount to the rates for the newly installed SCVS channels or Hi-Def DVTS channels, as applicable.

The attached tariff pages provide a complete description of the eligibility requirements, subscription requirements, terms and conditions and rates and charges applicable of this new contract tariff option.
