The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) hereby apply for Special Permission for a waiver of Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules.

Verizon intends to introduce a new contract tariff option in its Access Service Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 (FCC1). The new contract tariff option provides billing discounts on certain Special Access Services to customers who meet the eligibility requirements and maintain volume commitments and total billed revenue amounts for High Capacity 1.544 Mbps (DS1) and High Capacity 44.736 Mbps (DS3) Services.

Verizon requests special permission to waive the requirements of Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to allow FCC1 to make reference to Verizon's Tariffs F.C.C. No. 11, 14 and 16 for the purpose of aggregating billed revenue across Verizon's four access service tariffs, and determining if a customer has met the minimum billed revenue criteria necessary for subscription to the new contract tariff option.
