This application is hereby made by Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) for Special Permission to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to make references in NBTC Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Access Service Offer, Contract Offer No. ZZZ, to the similar contract tariffs of the following AT&T Telephone Companies: Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) Tariff F.C.C. No. 73; The Southern New England Telephone (SNET) Tariff F.C.C. No. 39; and Pacific Bell Telephone company (PBTC) Tariff F.C.C. No. 1; (collectively AT&T Telephone Companies).

With this filing NBTC is proposing to introduce Contract Offer No. ZZZ – Access Service Offer, a multi-regional access discount plan, for which concurrent subscription is required to the following Access Tariffs: Pacific Bell Telephone Company (PBTC) Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Contract Offer No. XXX; The Southern New England Telephone (SNET) Tariff F.C.C. No. 39, Contract Offer No. YYY; Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) Tariff F.C.C. No. 73, Contract Offer No. WWW; and Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Contract Offer No. ZZZ. This Contract Offer No. ZZZ permits Customers that meet the Eligibility Criteria in Section 23.ZZZ.3, and the Terms and Conditions in Section 23.ZZZ.4, to purchase Subject Services in Section 23.XXX.2 and receive credits as listed in Section 23.ZZZ.5. This Contract Offer No. ZZZ requires eligible Customers to comply with a Minimum Annual Revenue Commitment (MARC), as described in Section 23.ZZZ.4. The MARC includes recurring revenues from all Contributory Services purchased from the Qualified Companies eligible under this Contract Offer and the concurrently purchased Contract Offers. This Contract Offer No. ZZZ is available for subscription from December X, 2008 through January X, 2009. This Contract Offer is not renewable.

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With this application, NBTC requests permission to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to include the above mentioned tariff references in its proposed contract tariff filing. Applications to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules are also being requested by SWBT, SNET and PBTC in separate applications.

In accordance with Section 61.14, this application letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS) in compliance with the electronic filing procedures.

Payment in the amount of \$775.00 has been electronically transmitted to the U.S. Bank in St. Louis, Missouri, in accordance with the fee program procedures.
