Issued under authority of Special Permission No. 99-42, the NTCs are filing changes to tariff material not yet in effect for thirty days on less than statutory notice. On March 15, 1999, the NTCs filed Transmittal No. 540, which introduced Service Provider Number Portability (SPNP) Query, Database Query, and Database Service Activation and/or Rearrangement Nonrecurring Charges. Transmittal No. 540 is scheduled to become effective on March 30, 1999. With this filing, the NTCs are revising material filed under Transmittal No. 540 to correct supporting documentation and the resulting rates.
