INTRODUCTION

The Verizon Telephone Companies are submitting tariff pages to introduce Contract Tariff Option 55 (Option 55) in its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 (FCC 1) and Contract Tariff Option 53 (Option 53) in its Tariff F.C.C. No. 11 (FCC 11).

DESCRIPTION

These options provide Commercial Mobile Radio Services providers who satisfy the eligibility requirements and other requirements as set forth in the attached tariff pages with billing credits that are applied to each eligible cell site within Local Access and Transport Areas (LATAs) 132 (New York Metropolitan LATA) and 224 (North Jersey LATA).

Contract Tariff Option 55 of FCC 1 and Contract Tariff Option 53 of FCC 11 are filed pursuant to Verizon receiving Pricing Flexibility relief for Special Access Services in qualifying Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs)¹.

The attached tariff pages provide a complete description of the eligibility requirements, subscription requirements, terms and conditions and rates and charges of Option 55 of FCC 1 and Option 53 of FCC 11.
