This application is hereby made by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) for Special Permission to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to make references in BellSouth Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Access Service Offer, Contract Offer No. 64, to the similar contract tariffs of the following AT&T Telephone Companies: Pacific Bell Telephone Company (PBTC) Tariff F.C.C. No. 1; The Southern New England Telephone (SNET) Tariff F.C.C. No. 39; Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) Tariff F.C.C. No. 73; and Ameritech Operating Companies (Ameritech) Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, (collectively AT&T Telephone Companies).

With this filing BellSouth is proposing to introduce Contract Offer No. 64 – Access Service Offer, a multi-regional access discount plan, for which concurrent subscription is required to the following Access Tariffs: BellSouth Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Contract No. 64; PBTC Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Contract Offer No. 150; SNET Tariff F.C.C. No. 39, Contract Offer No. 44; SWBT Tariff F.C.C. No. 73, Contract Offer No. 163; and Ameritech Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, Contract Offer No. 186. This Contract Offer No. 64 permits Customers that meet the Eligibility Criteria in Section 25.67.3, and the Terms and Conditions in Section 25.67.4, to purchase Subject Services in Section 25.67.2 and receive credits as listed in Section 25.67.6. This Contract Offer No. 64 requires eligible Customers to comply with a Minimum Annual Revenue Commitment (MARC), as described in Section 25.67.5. The MARC includes recurring revenues from all Contributory Services purchased from the Qualified Companies eligible under this Contract Offer and the Concurrently Subscribed Contract Offers. This Contract Offer is not renewable.

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With this application, BellSouth requests permission to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to include the above mentioned tariff references in its proposed contract tariff filing. Applications to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules are also being requested by PBTC, SNET, SWBT and Ameritech in separate applications.

In accordance with Section 61.14, this application letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS) in compliance with the electronic filing procedures.

Payment in the amount of \$815.00 has been electronically transmitted to the U.S. Bank in St. Louis, Missouri, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS as a proprietary document. These actions have been committed on the date established as the issued (filed) date as reflected above.
