Verizon is submitting tariff pages to introduce a new contract tariff option in its Access Service Tariff FCC No. 1 (FCC 1) and FCC No. 11 (FCC 11). The new contract tariff options enable a customer to earn credits by ordering Special Access High Capacity 1.544 Mbps (DS1) Services and/or Special Access High Capacity 44.736 Mbps (DS3) Services between August 1, 2009 and October 31, 2009. The customer may apply these earned credits towards payment of the nonrecurring charges and monthly recurring charges for its future purchases of DS1 and DS3 Services that are installed between January 1, 2010 and June 30, 2010 as further described in the new contract tariff options. These new contract tariff options are being filed in FCC 1 and FCC 11 where Verizon has received Pricing Flexibility relief for Special Access Services in Qualifying Metropolitan Statistical Areas.

Supporting material as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is not required with this filing. However, a document with a detailed explanation of the filing is being provided as an attachment hereto.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
