7.9 Video Service

7.9.1 Basic Channel Description

A Video channel is a channel with one-way transmission capability for a standard 525 line/60 field monochrome, or National Television Systems Committee (NTSC) color, video signal and one or more audio signals, as described below. The provision and the bandwidth of the associated audio signal(s) is a function of the channel interface selected by the customer. Video channels are provided between customer designated premises or between a customer designated premises and a Telephone Company hub or hubs, where available. (T)

(A) Analog Video Service

Broadcast Video service channels provide one-way transmission of NTSC video signals between two customer designated premises or between a customer designated premises and a Telephone Company hub, where available, using fiber optic facilities. A NTSC video channel provides standard 525 line/60 field monochrome, or NTSC color video signal with up to four (4) associated 20 kHz audio signals. The bandwidth for analog video service is 30 Hz to 6.6 MHz. (C)

Broadcast Video services are provided where facilities are available. Where facilities are not available, Special Construction may apply. (N)
