Application is hereby made by Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) for Special Permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw Transmittal 202 without its becoming effective.

On October 26, 2009, NBTC proposed various modifications to its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. The modifications were to update the Basic Channel Description for Analog Video Service in order to standardize the descriptions for analog video services in all AT&T regional companies. Transmittal 202 is scheduled to become effective on November 10, 2009.

With this application, NBTC requests permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw material filed under Transmittal No. 202 without its becoming effective, and to restore currently effective material. NBTC wishes to withdraw Transmittal No. 202 in order to review issues identified in the proposed modifications and to ensure that there is no loss in functionality to customers as a result of the verbiage standardization.

This Application letter and the appropriate illustrative tariff page are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
