Under authority of Special Permission No. 09-030 of the Federal Communications Commission, Verizon is submitting tariff pages to introduce a new contract tariff option in its Tariff FCC Nos. 1, 11 and 14. This new Contract Option provides certain discounts and Billing Credits on Special Access High Capacity 1.544 Mbps (DS1) and 44.736 Mbps (DS3) Services, subject to the requirements set forth in the attached tariff pages. The new Contract Option also provides additional discounts and Billing Credits upon the conversion by the customer of a minimum of seventy-five percent (75%) of each of its in-service DS1 and DS3 Unbundled Loops, DS1 and

DS3 Unbundled Transport, DS1 and DS3 EELs, and DS1 and DS3 Commingled EELs to Qualifying Services, subject to the requirements set forth in the attached tariff pages.

Supporting material as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is not required with this filing. However, a document with a detailed explanation of the filing is being provided as an attachment hereto.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
