In this filing Qwest is updating tariff pages to reflect the consolidation of Malheur Home Telephone (Malheur) into Qwest's Oregon operations. Since Malheur will cease to exist after the merger and in order to impact the fewest number of customers, rates for Malheur EUCL and Federal Universal Service Fund Charges (Centrex Factor and Multiline Business Factor) will be changed to the existing Oregon rates, the state in which Malheur customers reside. Malheur customers have already been notified of this pending change.

Qwest will reflect the movement of Malheur line counts from the Idaho (Boise LATA) Study area to the Oregon study area in its 2010 Annual Price Cap Tariff Filing and rates will be adjusted as appropriate. Federal Universal Service Fund Charges will be adjusted at the time of the next USF factor change.

As part of this filing Qwest also plans to update the CEMSS Technical Publication reference.

Supporting information discussed under Sections 61.38 and 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is, to the extent required, included in this transmittal letter and the attached documentation.
