With this transmittal, Verizon is submitting tariff pages to make the following changes:

- In Tariff FCC No. 1, revise Billing Name and Address (BNA) to eliminate magnetic tape as a medium option. Also, the rate structure applicable to BNA is being revised to eliminate the Developmental Charge for the initial set up and to zero rate the electronic data transmission record charge. The remaining rate applicable to customers is the “per record” charge.
- In Tariff FCC No. 11, revise BNA to eliminate the option of requesting BNA on a manual basis, by either voice telecommunications or mail or messages originated from data terminal numbers. BNA is also being revised to eliminate magnetic tape as a mechanized option. Also, the rate structure applicable to BNA is being revised to eliminate the Service Establishment Charge for the initial establishment of service. The remaining rate applicable to customers is the “per message processed” charge.
- In Tariff FCC Nos. 14 and 16, remove Presubscription List, Allocation List, End User Validation List, and Line Range Reports, all of which are obsolete options for which there is no demand. In addition, Snapshot Lists are being revised to eliminate magnetic tape and paper as media options.

Supporting material as described under Section 61.49 of the Commission’s rules is included with this filing.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the FCC’s Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
