With this filing Verizon removes Internet Protocol – Virtual Private Network (IP-VPN) service from Tariff FCC No. 1 and Tariff FCC No. 20. IP-VPN was grandfathered to existing customers on September 30, 2006 under Transmittal No. 738. There are currently no IP-VPN customers purchasing service under Tariff FCC No. 1 or Tariff FCC No. 20. Verizon is removing references to IP-VPN found in Tariff FCC Nos. 11 and 14. Also, as part of this filing, Verizon is making an administrative correction to include two remote offices in the MSA list in Tariff FCC No. 1 and correcting a typographical error in Tariff FCC No. 11. There is no impact to customers as a result of either of these corrections.

Supporting material as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commission's rules is not required for this filing. There was no Price Cap base period demand for IP-VPN in the Price Cap Indices filed in the 2009 Annual Filing. Therefore, there is no impact on any of the Price Cap indices. All the elements will be removed from the Price Cap detail with the next filing requiring Price Cap support.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
