DESCRIPTION

The Verizon Telephone Companies (“Verizon”) are submitting tariff pages to introduce a new Contract Tariff Option (“Contract Option”) in its Tariff FCC Nos. 1 and 11. With this Contract Option, the customer can receive discounted rates for certain rate elements of Special Access High Definition Digital Video Transport Service (Hi-Def DVTS) and Serial Component Video Service (SCVS) when the customer satisfies a minimum revenue commitment that must be met by month thirty-six (36) of the three (3) year Service Period. During the Service Period, the Telephone Company will conduct an annual review occurring in months 12, 24 and 36 to track the customer’s progression towards achieving the revenue commitment that must be met by the end of the Service Period. The customer also has the option to extend the Service Period for an additional three (3) years during which time the minimum revenue commitment must also be met in months 48, 60 and 72 of the extended Service Period.

This new Contract Option is filed pursuant to the Pricing Flexibility relief granted to Verizon in certain qualifying Metropolitan Statistical Areas (“MSAs”).¹ The new Contract Option is introduced as Contract Tariff Option 61 in Tariff F.C.C No. 1 and Option 59 in Tariff F.C.C. No. 11.

A complete description of the terms and conditions of this new Contract Option is included in the attached tariff pages.
