3.1 GeneralDescription

CarrierCommonLineAccessprovidesfortheuseof endusers'TelephoneCompany providedcommonlinesbycustomersforaccesstosuchenduserstofurnishInterstate Communications.

PremiumAccessisSwitchedAccessService,otherthantheDNALBSA,providedto customersunderthisstariffwhichfurnishinterstateMTS/WATSandSwitchedAccessService inanendofficeconvertedtoequalaccess.

NonPremiumAccessisSwitchedAccessService,otherthantheDNALBSA,providedinan endofficenotyetconvertedtoequalaccesstocustomersthatdonotfurnishinterstate MTS/WATS.

ASpecialAccessSurcharge,assetforthin7.5.14 following,willapplytointerstatespecial accessserviceprovidedbytheTelephoneCompanyto a customer,inaccordancewith regulationsassetforthin7.4.2following.

3. CarrierCommonLineAccessService (Cont'd)3.2 Limitations (Cont'd)3.2 Limitations3.2.1 Exclusions

Neither telephonenumber nor detail billing are provided with Carrier Common Line Access. Additionally, directory listings and inter-cept arrangements are not included in the rates and charges for Carrier Common Line Access.

Carrier Common Line Service is not available with the DNALBSA.

Carrier Common Line Service is not available with Switched Access Service when provided in conjunction with a MTSO type or I line connection.

3.2.2 Access Groups

All line side connections provided in the same access group will be limited to the same features and operating characteristics.

All trunk side connections provided in the same access group will be limited to the same features and operating characteristics.

Carrier Common Line Service is not available with the DNALBSA.

Carrier Common Line Service is not available with Switched Access Service when provided in conjunction with a MTSO type or I line connection.

Carrier Common Line Service does not apply to FGD minutes of use originated from a Telecommunication Relay Service (TRS) Center.

3.2.3 WATS Access Lines

Where Switched Access Services are connected with Special Access Services at Telephone Company Designated WATS Serving Offices or the provision of WATS or WATS-type Services, Switched Access Service minutes which are carried on that end of the service (i.e., originating minutes for outward WATS and WATS-type services and terminating minutes for inward WATS and WATS-type services) shall not be assessed Carrier Common Line Access per minute charges with the following exception. Carrier Common Line Access per minute charges shall apply when Lineside BSA switched access is ordered from a non-equal access telephone company office that does not have measurement capabilities and the assumed minutes are used. average access minutes, as set forth in 6.8.8 follow.

3. CarrierCommonLineAccessService (Cont'd)3.3 UndertakingoftheTelephoneCompany3.3.1 ProvisionofService

WherethecustomerisprovidedSwitchedAccessServiceunderothersectionsof this tariff, the Telephone Company will provide the use of Telephone Company common lines by a customer for access to end users at rates and charges as set forth in 3.8 following.

3.3.2 InterstateandIntrastateUse

The Switched Access Service provided by the Telephone Company includes the Switched Access Service provided for both interstate and intrastate communications. The Carrier Common Line Access rates and charges as set forth in 3.9 following apply to interstate Switched Access Service access minutes in accordance with the rate regulations as set forth in 2.3.10 preceding (Jurisdictional Reports Requirements).

3.4 ObligationsoftheCustomer3.4.1 SwitchedAccessServiceRequirement

The Switched Access Service associated with Carrier Common Line Access shall be ordered by the customer under other sections of this tariff.

3.4.2 Supervision

The customer facilities at the premises of the ordering customer shall provide the necessary on-hook and off-hook supervision.

Whenthecustomerreportsinterstateandintrastate useofSwitchedAccessService, theassociatedCarrierCommonLineAccessusedby hecustomerforinterstatewill bedeterminedassetforthin2.3.10preceding.

3.5.2 SwitchedAccessServiceProvidedinConjunctionwithaCellularExchangeCarrier (CEC)oraRadioCommonCarrier(RCC)

ForSwitchedAccessservicesminutesofuseprovidedinconjunctionwithaCECor RCCTypelcall,CarrierCommonLineratesdonotapply.

WhencreditforCarrierCommonLinechargesmustbe madeandtheTelephone Companycannotdeterminethecreditadjustmentfor CarrierCommonLinecharges, thecustomershallberesponsibleforprovidingdocumentationforuseindetermining thecreditamount.Documentation,suppliedbythe customer,shallbesuppliedeach monthandshallidentifytheinvolvedSwitchedAccessservicesminutesofuse,both premiumandnon-premium,forwhichaCarrierCommon Linecreditadjustmentis due.Themonthlyperiodusedtodeterminetheminutesofuseshallbethemost recentmonthlyperiodforwhichthecustomerhasreceivedabillforsuchSwitched Accessservices.TheinformationshallbedeliveredtotheTelephoneCompany,in atimelymanner.IftherequiredinformationisnotreceivedbytheTelephone Company,asdescribedpreceding,themostrcentreportedinformationwillbeused forthenexttwomonths.Subsequentcreditsorallocationsforadditionalmonthswill bemadeaftertherequireddocumentation,asdescribedpreceding,isdeliveredto theTelephoneCompanybythecustomer.

TheCarrierCommonLinecreditadjustmentshallapplyforSwitchedAccess servicesminutesofuseprovidedinconjunctionwithaCECorRCCTypelcalls, providedCarrierCommonLinechargeshavebeenassessedonsuchservices.

3.5.3 LocalExchangeAccessandEnhancedServicesExemption

Whenaccesstothelocalexchangeisrequiredtoprovidecustomerservice(e.g., MTS/WATS-type,telex,Data,etc.)thatusesaresoloprivatelineservice,Switched AccessServiceRatesandRegulations,assetforthfollowingwillapply, exceptwhensuchaccesstothelocalexchangeisrequiredforthe provisionofan enhancedservice.CarrierCommonLineAccessratesandchargesassetforthin 3.8followingapplyinaccordancewiththeresalerateregulationsassetforthin3.6.4 following.

3. CarrierCommonLineAccessService (Cont'd)3.6 ResoldServices3.6.1 Scope

Where a customer is reselling MTS and/or MTS-type service(s) on which the Carrier Common Line and Switched Access charges have been assessed, the customer may, at the option of the customer, obtain Lineside BSA, Trunkside BSA-950 Option, Trunkside BSA-101XXXX Option, Feature Group A, Feature Group B or Feature Group D Switched Access Service under this tariff as set forth in Section 6. following for originating and/or terminating access in the local exchange. Such access group arrangements whether single lines or trunks or multiline hunt groups or trunk groups will have Carrier Common Line Access charges applied as set forth in 3.8 following in accordance with the resaler rate regulations set forth in 3.6.4 following. For purposes of administering this provision:

Resold interstate terminating MTS and MTS-type service(s) shall include collect calls, third number calls and credit card calls whether the reseller pays the underlying carrier's service charges; and shall not include intrastate minutes of use.

Resold interstate originating MTS and MTS-type service(s) shall not include collect, third number, credit card or intrastate minutes of use.

3.6.2 Customer Obligations Concerning the Resale of MTS and MTS-type Services

When the customer is reselling MTS and/or MTS-type service as set forth in 3.6.1 preceding, the customer will be charged Carrier Common Line Access charges in accordance with the resaler rate regulations as set forth in 3.6.4 following if the customer or the provider of the MTS service furnish es documentation of the MTS usage and/or the customer furnishes documentation of the MTS-type usage. Such documentations supplied by the customer shall be supplied each month and shall identify the involved resold MTS and/or MTS-type services.

The monthly period used to determine the minutes of use for resold MTS and/or MTS-type service(s) shall be the most recent monthly period for which the customer has received a bill for such resold service(s). This information shall be delivered to the Telephone Company, at a location specified by the Telephone Company, no later than 15 days after the bill date shown on the resold MTS and/or MTS-type service bill. If the required information is not received by the Telephone Company, the previously reported information, as described preceding, will be used for the next two months. For any subsequent month, no allocation or credit will be made until the required documentation is delivered to the Telephone Company by the customer.

WhenthecustomerutilizesSwitchedAccessServices assetforthin3.6.2 preceding,theTelephoneCompanymayrequestacert ifiedcopyofthecustomer's resoldMTSorMTS-typeusagebillingfromeitherth ecustomerortheproviderofthe MTSorMTS-typeService.Requestsforbillingwill relatebacknomorethan12 monthspriortothecurrentbillingperiod.

3.6.4 RateRegulationsConcerningtheResaleofMTS andMTS-typeServices

Whenthecustomerisprovidedanaccessgrouptobe usedinconjunctionwiththe resaleofMTSand/orMTS-typeservicesassetforth in3.6.1preceding,subjectto thelimitationsassetforthin3.2preceding,and theTelephoneCompanyreceives theusageinformationrequiredassetforthin3.6. 2preceding,tocalculatethe adjustmentofCarrierCommonLineAccesscharges,t hecustomerwillbebilledas setforthin(D),(E)or(F)following,dependingu pon;respectively,whethertheusage isfromnonequalaccessoffices,equalofficesor acombinationofthetwo.

(A) ApportionmentandAdjustmentofResoldMinutes ofUse

Whenthecustomerisprovidedwithmorethanoneac cessgroupinaLATAin associationwiththeresaleofMTSand/orMTS-type services,theresold minutesofusewillbeapportionedasfollows:

(1) OriginatingServices

TheTelephoneCompanywillapportiontheresoldori ginatingMTS and/orMTS-typeservicesandoriginatingminutesof useforwhichthe resalecreditadjustmentapplies,amongtheaccess groups.Such apportionmentwillbebasedontherelationshipof theoriginatingusage foreachaccessgrouptothetotaloriginatingusag eforallaccess groupsintheLATA.Forpurposesofadministering thisprovision:

ResoldoriginatingMTSand/orMTS-typeservicesmin utesshallbeonly thoseattributabletointerstateoriginatingMTSan d/orMTS-type minutesandshallnotincludecollect,thirdnumber ,creditcardor intrastateminutesofuse.

Theresalecreditadjustmentshallapplyforresold originatingMTSand MTS-typeservicesandminutesofuse,providedCarr ierCommonLine andSwitchedAccessChargeshavebeenassessedons uchservices.

TheTelephoneCompanywillapportiontheresoldterminatingMTS and/orMTS-typeservicesandterminatingminutesof useforwhichthe resalecreditadjustmentapplies,amongtheaccess groups.Such apportionmentwillbebasedontherelationshipof theterminating usageforeachaccessgrouptotheotalterminating usageforall accessgroupsintheLATA.Forpurposesofadministeringthis provision:

ResoldterminatingMTSand/orMTS-typeservicesminutesshall beonlythoseattributabletointerstateterminatingMTS/MTS-type (i.e.,collectcalls,thirdnumbercalls,andcreditcardcalls)and shallnotincludetrastateminutesofuseorMTS/ MTS-type minutesofusepaidforbyanotherparty.

TheresalecreditadjustmentshallapplyforresoldterminatingMTSand MTS-typeservicesandminutesofuse,providedCarrierCommonLine andSwitchedAccessChargeshavebeenassessedonsuchservices.

(B) SameState/TelephoneCompany/ExchangeLimitation

Inorderfortherateregulationstoapplyassetforth in(D),(E)or(F)following, theaccessgroupsandtheresoldMTSand/orMTS-typeservicesmustbe providedinthesamestate(exceptwhenthesameextendedareaservice arrangementisprovidedintwodifferentstatesby thesametelephone company)inthesameexchange,providedbythesame TelephoneCompany andconnecteddirectlyorindirectly.Forthoseexchanges thatencompass morethanonestate,thecustomershallreportthe informationbystatewithin theexchange.

EachoftheaccessgrouparrangementsusedbythecustomerinassociationwiththeresoldMTSand/orMTS-typeservicesmustbeconnectioneitherdirectlyorindirectlytothecustomerdesignatedpremisesatwhichtheresoldMTSand/orMTS-typeservicesareterminated.DirectconnectionsarethosearrangementswheretheaccessgroupsandresoldMTS and/orMTS-type servicesareterminatedatthesamecustomerdesignatedpremises.

Indirectoriginatingconnectionsarethosearrangementswheretheaccess groupsandtheresoldoriginatingMTSand/orMTS-typeservicesare physicallylocatedatdifferentcustomerdesignated premisesinthesame exchange.Suchdifferentcustomerdesignatedpremisesareconnectedby facilities that permit a call to flow from access group storesoldMTSand/or MTS-typeservices.

Indirectterminatingconnectionsarethosearrangementswheretheaccess groupsandresoldterminatingMTSand/orMTS-typeservicesarephysically locatedatdifferentcustomerdesignatedpremisesinthesameexchange. Suchdifferentcustomerdesignatedpremisesareconnectedbyfacilities that permit a call to flow from resoldterminatingMTSand/orMTS-typeservicesto accessgroups.

(D) AccessGroups-NonEqualAccessOfficesOnly

Theadjustmentsassetforthhereandin(E)and(F)followingwillbe computedseparatelyforeachaccessgroup.

Whenalltheusageonanaccessgrouporiginatesfromand/orterminatesat endoffices that have not been converted to equal access the Non Premium Access Charge per minute asset forth in 3.8 following will apply. The Access Charge will be the adjusted originating interstate access minutes plus the adjusted terminating interstate access minutes for such access groups.

Theadjustedoriginatingaccessminuteswillbetheoriginatinginterstate accessminuteslessthereportedresoldoriginating MTSand/orMTS-type serviceminutesofuseassetforth(A)(1)preceding;butnotlessthanzero. Theadjustedterminatingaccessminuteswillbethe terminatinginterstate accessminuteslessthereportedresoldterminating MTSand/orMTS-type serviceminutesofuseassetforth(A)(2)preceding;butnotlessthanzero.

The adjustment asset for thin (D), (E) and (F) preceding will be made to the involved customer account no later than either the next bill date, or the one subsequent to that, depending on when the usage report is obtained.

(H) ConversionofBilledUsagetoMinutes

When the MTS and/or MTS-type usage is shown in hours, the number of hours shall be multiplied by 60 to develop the associated MTS and/or MTS-type minutes of use. If the MTS and/or MTS-type usage is shown in a unit that does not show hours or minutes, the customer shall provide a factor to convert the shown unit to minutes.

(I) PercentInterstateUse(PIU)

The adjustment asset for thin (D), (E) and (F) preceding will be made to the involved customer account after making the adjustments to the customer account asset for thin 2.3.10 preceding.

3.7 RateRegulations3.7.1 BillingofCharges

Carrier Common Line charges will be billed to each Switched Access Service provided under this tariff in accordance with the regulations asset for thin 3.7.5 following (Determination of Premium and Non-Premium Charges) except asset for thin 3.6.4 preceding (Resale) and 3.7.4 following (PIU).

3. CarrierCommonLineAccessService (Cont'd)3.7 RateRegulations (Cont'd)3.7.2 MeasuringandRecordingofCallDetail

When access minutes are used to determine Carrier Common Line charges, they will be accumulated using call detail recorded by Telephone Company equipment except as set forth in 3.7.3 following (Unmeasured Lineside BSA and FGA) and Trunkside BSA-MTS/WATS Option and Feature Group C operator and automated operator service systems call details such as pay telephone sent-paid, operator-DDD, operator-person, collect, credit-card, third number and/or other like calls recorded by the customer. The Telephone Company measuring and recording equipment, except as set forth in 3.7.3 following (Unmeasured Lineside BSA and FGA), will be associated with end office or local tandem switching equipment and will record each originating and terminating access minute where answers supervision is received. The accumulated access minutes will be summed on a line by line basis, by line group or by end office, whichever type of account is used by the Telephone Company, for each customer and then rounded to the nearest minute.

3.7.3 Unmeasured Lineside BSA and Feature Group A

When Carrier Common Line Access is provided in association with Lineside BSA and Feature Group A Switched Access Service in Telephone Company offices that are not equipped for measurement capabilities, an assumed average interstate access minutes will be used to determine Carrier Common Line Access charges. These assumed access minutes are as set forth in 6.8.8 following.

3.7.4 Percent Interstate Use (PIU)

When the customer reports interstate and intrastate use of in-service Switched Access Service, Carrier Common Line charges will be billed only to interstate Switched Access Service access minutes based on the data reported by the customer as set forth in 2.3.10 preceding (Jurisdictional Reports), except where the Telephone Company is billing according to actual jurisdiction. Interstate Switched Access Service access minutes will, after adjustment as set forth in 3.6.4 preceding (Resale), when necessary, be used to determine Carrier Common Line Charges as set forth in 3.7.5 following.

- (A) AccessminutesforallpremiumratedSwitchedAccessServicessubjectto CarrierCommonLinechargeswillbemultipliedbythePremiumAccessper minuterateassetforthin3.8following.
- (B) Accessminutesforallnon-premiumratedSwitchedAccessServicessubjectto CarrierCommonLinechargeswillbemultipliedbytheNon-PremiumAccess perminuterateassetforthin3.8following.
- (C) CarrierCommonLinechargesshallnotbereducedassetforthin3.6.1 precedingunlessSwitchedAccessCharges,assetforthinSection6. following,areappliedtothecustomer'sSwitchedAccessServices.
- (D) TerminatingPremiumAccessorNon-PremiumAccesses,perminutecharge(s) applyto:
- allterminatingaccessminutesofuse;
 - AlloriginatingaccessminutesofuseassociatedwithLinesideBSAand FGAAccessServiceswheretheoff-hook supervisory signalingis forwardedbythecustomer'sequipmentwhenthecalledpartyanswers;
 - alloriginatingaccessminutesofuseassociatedwithcallsplacedto 700,TollFree,and900numbers,lessthoseoriginatingaccessminutes ofuseassociatedwithcallsplacedto700,TollFreeand900numbers reportedtoeitherthecustomerorthe carrierfor eachmonthar numberofcallsorminutesorareportofthepercentageofcallsorminutes assessedCarrier CommonLinecharges."TollFree"serviceincludes anyaccessservice whichutilizesthefollowingNPA's:800,888,877, 866,855,844,833, and822astheybecomeavailabletotheindustry.
