The accompanying tariff materials issued by The Chillicothe Telephone Company, Inc. (Chillicothe) (**FRN #0005-0973-81**), and bearing FCC No. 1, effective August 25, 2010, are sent to you in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended and pursuant to the Commission's Rules.

The purpose of the filed tariff materials is to clarify that no rates exist in the tariff for the tandem switched facility and tandem switched termination elements of Chillicothe's tandem switched transport service, and to de-tariff Chillicothe's common carrier asymmetrical digital subscriber line transmission service pursuant to the Commission's permissive de-tariffing option.
