This filing introduces DS3 Transmuxing in Tariff FCC Nos. 1, 11, 14 and 16 as an option for Verizon-provided point to point SONET services. DS3 Transmuxing is an arrangement that performs a DS3 to DS1 conversion allowing a single DS3 Transmux arrangement to be associated with up to twenty-eight (28) DS1 circuits.

Supporting material as described under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is not required with this filing. However, a document with a detailed explanation of the filing is being provided as an attachment. In addition, Figure 1 is provided as an attachment to this filing and will be used in the 2011 Annual Filing to demonstrate that the new rate elements being introduced in FCC Nos. 1, 11, and 14 should be granted the same Phase I or Phase II regulatory relief in the Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) and the non-MSAs where the service category has been granted such relief.
