6.18 Universal Service Fund Charge

The Universal Service Fund (USF) charge provides for affordable local telephone service for all Customers and provides a discount to schools, libraries and low-income families.

The USF charge will be assessed to end user Customers who order Special Access Services, from this tariff. The USF charge will be determined by multiplying a USF Surcharge factor of 0.129 by the end user Customer's monthly billing account level interstate charges for these services. (R)

The USF charge will also be assessed to end user Customers on Other Incidental Charges. A USF Surcharge factor of 0.129 will be applied to the following nonrecurring charges: (R)

- Nonrecurring Charge for Presubscribed Interexchange Carrier
- Primary Interexchange Carrier Charge

To the extent the Nonrecurring Charge for Presubscribed Interexchange carrier is billed to an IC, as set forth in 6.5.6 and 6.5.7, the USF Surcharge will apply to the IC.

The USF charge, as shown in this section of the tariff, shall be assessed to Customers that are billed end user common line charges. These USF charges will not be assessed to Lifeline Customers, with the exception of the USF on Other Incidental Charges.

21.46 Contract Tariff Option 54

(N)

21.46.1 Scope

- (A) Contract Tariff Option 54, a dedicated Interisland DS3 Service, is an offering for new installations of Special Access High Capacity DS3 service connecting two premises or wire centers in Hawaii.
- (B) The regulations, terms and conditions provided in this Section 21.46 apply to all Customers who subscribe to Contract Tariff Option 54 for new services in the applicable Non-Metropolitan Statistical Areas (Non-MSA) during the specified Service Order Period set forth below.

21.46.2 Eligible Services

This is an offering exclusively for new installations of DS3 service between a wire center on the island of Oahu and a wire center on the island of Lanai. The quantity and terms are provided in Section 21.46.5 following.

21.46.3 Serving Area

The serving areas for the dedicated DS3 service of this Option are comprised of the Mililani Mobile Switching Center on one (1) end of the route and Lanai wire center at the other end. All services that originate and terminate at End User locations are not covered under this Option.

21.46.4 Eligibility Requirements

All of the following requirements must be satisfied to be eligible for subscription to Contract Tariff Option 54.

- (A) Customers who wish to subscribe to a Hawaiian Telcom dedicated Interisland DS3 Service under this Contract Tariff Option 54 must do so by submitting a written request in a manner designated by the Telephone Company during the Service Order Period which ends on October 31, 2010.
- (B) The eligible Interisland DS3 service and associated rate elements described in Section 21.46.2 preceding and Section 21.46.5 following must be ordered on a term plan as allowed for by Hawaiian Telcom.

21.46.4 Eligibility Requirements, (cont'd)

- (C) The Customer must accept service on the original service date. If the Customer does not accept service on the original service date, any change to a later date will make the service ineligible for the discount, unless the change is initiated by the Telephone Company.
- (D) A new service cannot be a service that was disconnected from another contract option, discount plan, or tariff arrangement in order to include that service in this plan.

21.46.5 Description of the Plan

- (A) Contract Tariff Option 54 offers the eligible Customer the discounted rates set forth below for the specified term of sixty (60) months (Service Term). Except for service provided under another contract tariff in this Section 21 for which minimum revenue or total revenue is measured on a contract level basis, or a term plan as described under Section 5.7 preceding, service subscribed to under this tariff is not eligible for any other service, term or volume discount for services offered under Contract Tariff Option 54.
- (B) Minimum Service Requirements: one (1) dedicated interisland DS3 circuit is required between the Mililani Mobile Switching Center and the location specified in Section 21.46.3 preceding.

Any additions ordered after the Service Term ends will be billed at the then effective tariffed rates as set forth in Section 5.7 preceding and, as such, shall not be eligible under the Plan.

21.46.6 Terms and Conditions

Unless superseded by the terms and conditions set forth herein, all terms and conditions, including term liability and minimum periods, as stated in Section 5.7 preceding, apply to the Contract Tariff Option 54 service

(A) Upon subscription, as set forth in Section 21.46.4 preceding, the Customer shall commit to a term for a period of sixty (60) consecutive months (Service Term).

(B) If service is canceled in whole or in part or terminates prior to the expiration of the Service Term, the Customer shall be responsible for payment of a Termination Charge equal to the sum of: 1) one hundred percent (100%) of all remaining monthly recurring charges for the first year of the Service Commitment Period, 2) fifty percent (50%) of all remaining monthly recurring charges for the second year of the Service Commitment Period, and 3) twenty-five percent (25%) of the applicable monthly unit rate for the third, fourth and fifth years of the Service Commitment Period, multiplied by the number of months remaining in the unexpired portion of the Service Commitment Period. Any such Termination Charges shall be due and payable in one lump sum within thirty (30) days of Customer's receipt of such invoice.
