Cincinnati Bell Telephone (CBT) hereby applies for Special Permission pursuant to Section 61.51 of the Commission's Rules for waiver of Sections 61.58 (Notice Requirements) and 61.59 (Effective Period Required Before Changes) on not less than 1 day's notice in order to include the reduced End User Common Line (EUCL) rates that were inadvertently omitted from Transmittal No. 850, filed on September 16, 2010. Transmittal No. 850 is scheduled to take effect October 1, 2010.

On September 16, 2010, CBT filed Transmittal No. 850 to become effective on October 1, 2010. Transmittal No. 850 was a mid-year Tariff Review Plan (TRP) filing to reflect new Regulatory Fee and Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS) factors released by the Commission. In Transmittal No. 850, page 106, which contained CBT's proposed EUCL rate reductions was inadvertently omitted. CBT's Description & Justification, as well as its Tariff Review Plan (TRP) detailed and supported the reduction of CBT's EUCL rates from \$5.28 to \$5.24.

CBT respectfully requests permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules to allow CBT on not less than 1 day's notice to file the reduced EUCL rates effective October 1, 2010. Attached is the illustrative tariff page.

In accordance with the Commission's filing fee requirements, a filing fee of \$815.00 has been paid by credit card and an electronic Form 159 has been submitted.
