On October 13, 2010, the Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) filed Application No. 201, requesting a waiver of Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to introduce an optional 2011 National Service Level Agreement Plan and an optional 2011 Enhanced Service Level Agreement Plan in its Tariff FCC Nos. 1, 11 and 16, Access Service; and Tariff FCC No. 14, Facilities for Interstate Access. Subsequent to filing Application No. 201, the Commission found that the revision numbers contained in the Tariff FCC No. 1 illustrative tariff pages were inaccurate.
