This application is hereby made by Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) for Special Permission to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to make references in NBTC Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Access Service Offer, Contract Offer No. WW, to the similar contract tariffs of the following AT&T Telephone Companies: Ameritech Operating Companies (Ameritech) Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, Contract Offer No. UU; BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Contract Offer No. VV; Pacific Bell Telephone Company (PBTC) Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Contract Offer No. XX; The Southern New England Telephone (SNET) Tariff F.C.C. No. 39, Contract Offer No. YY; and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) Tariff F.C.C. No. 73 Contract Offer No. ZZ.

With this filing NBTC is proposing to offer the Special Access Service Offer (Contract Offer No. WW), which is a Minimum Annual Revenue Commitment plan for which concurrent subscription is required to this Contract Offer and to the above referenced Access Tariffs (collectively, Concurrently Subscribed Contract Offers).

With this application, NBTC requests permission to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to include the above mentioned tariff references in its proposed contract tariff filing. An application to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules is also being requested by Ameritech, BellSouth, PBTC, SNET and SWBT in separate filings.

In accordance with Section 61.14, this application letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS) in compliance with the electronic filing procedures.
