1. With this filing Verizon makes the following revisions to Tariff FCC Nos. 14 and 16:
 - Removes the Packet Switching Network Service which was grandfathered to existing customers on November 19, 2005, under Transmittal No. 638. There are currently no customers purchasing Packet Switching Network Service under these tariffs.
 - Replaces the list of NXX codes (e.g., 800, 877, 888) associated with toll free services with the term "Toll Free."
2. With this filing Verizon reinstates certain material inadvertently omitted from Tariff FCC No. 16 under Transmittal 1101 effective on August 11, 2010.
3. With this filing Verizon makes other administrative changes to Tariff FCC Nos. 1, 11, 14 and 16.
