This filing introduces regulations applicable to the migration of certain Special Access High Capacity 1.544 Mbps (DS1) level services and Special Access High Capacity 44.736 Mbps (DS3) level services that are provided under a Verizon term and/or volume plan to Telephone Company provided Ethernet services.

Supporting material as described under Section 61.49 of the Commission rules is required with this filing. However, Verizon has no base period demand for these technology migrations. Since there is no base period demand, there is no impact on price cap revenues or the Special Access price cap basket. Therefore, Tariff Review Plan (“TRP”) support is not included with this filing. However, a document with a detailed explanation of the filing is being provided as an attachment.
