The Verizon Telephone Companies¹ (Verizon) will file their 2011 Annual Price Cap Filing in compliance with Section 61.43 of the Commission's rules. As required by Section 61.49(k), attached is an advance submission of Verizon's 2011 Tariff

Review Plan (TRP) for the purpose of early review. The submission is in the format prescribed in the 2011 Tariff Review Plan Order.²

This filing provides the necessary inputs and documentation to calculate the new Price Cap Indices. The new Price Cap Indices reflect the use of the 2010 base period demand and changes in exogenous costs. All supporting documentation is provided as an attachment to this letter.
