Existing Issuing Carriers

As noted earlier, accompanying this transmittal letter at Appendix A is a listing of the existing issuing carriers for JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. For the existing issuing carriers, the filings made this year are the biennial filings for historic filers required in odd-numbered years under Section 61.39 of the Commission's rules. Of the existing issuing carriers for JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 who make mandatory filings on even-numbered years pursuant to Section 61.38 of the Commission's rules, only one company, Home Telephone Company of South Carolina, has elected to make a mid-course voluntary annual filing. This matter will be discussed in greater detail below.

New Issuing Carriers

Accompanying this transmittal letter at Appendix B is a table listing carriers which will become issuing carriers for JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 effective July 1, 2011. All carriers identified in Appendix B are currently in the existing National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) Traffic Sensitive Pool and are being cancelled by NECA as issuing carriers for NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 effective July 1, 2011 concurrent with the carriers becoming issuing carriers for JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1.

Mid-Course Filing for Home Telephone Company under Section 61.38

Home Telephone Company is making a mid course filing under Section 61.38. Pursuant to Section 61.38, supporting documentation accompanies this filing consistent with the requirements of the FCC Order noted above, regarding the Materials to be Filed in Support of 2011 Annual Access Tariff Filings. This mid-course filing is precipitated by a decrease in demand and the inability of Home Telephone Company to achieve its authorized rate of return.

FUSC Filing for Knology of the Valley, Inc.

For Knology of the Valley, Inc. (Knology), this filing proposes revision of the Federal Universal Service Charge (FUSC) factor reflective of a decrease in the Universal Service Contribution Factor from 14.9% to 14.4% for the third quarter of 2011. See Proposed Third Quarter 2011 Universal Service Contribution Factor, CC Docket No. 96-45, Public Notice, DA 11-1051 (released June 14, 2011). Knology is not a member of the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) Common Line Pool and therefore bills common line charges and related FUSC charges pursuant to JSI Tariff FCC No. 1. All remaining issuing carriers for JSI Tariff FCC No. 1 are members of and participate in the NECA Common Line Pool and reference NECA Tariff FCC No. 5 with respect to FUSC rates.

Pursuant to Section 61.32(b) of the Commission's Rules, the original of this letter, Form 159, and a check for \$815.00 have been sent via overnight delivery to the U.S. Bank, St. Louis, Missouri, as of this date.

- (1) Concurrent with this transmittal, the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) is cancelling the carrier as an issuing carrier for NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5. As an issuing carrier for JSI Tariff F.C.C. No.1, the carrier will provide services and bill charges pursuant to the rates, terms and conditions established in JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, including references for end-user services to rates established in NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5.
- (2) Carrier is exiting the NECA Traffic Sensitive Pool and filing as a new issuing carrier for JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, subject to Section 61.39 of the Commission's rules. For Section 61.39 carriers, biennial filings are required in odd-numbered years.
- (3) Carrier is a member of the NECA Common Line Pool. Rate sections in JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 for end user charges, including End User Common Line, ISDN, DS1 Channel Service and the Federal Universal Service Charge (FUSC) will reference NECA Tariff F.C.C No. 5 rates for the respective services.
- (4) WBIAS is Wireline Broadband Internet Access Service. Rate of Return Carriers who provide WBIAS must provide the service on a Title II common-carriage basis, either under tariff or on a permissively detariffed basis.
- (5) The TruVista Communications Companies have filed notice with the FCC to detariff WBIAS effective July 1, 2009.
