DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION
CONTRACT TARIFF NO. 50
TRANSMITTAL NO.25

FairPoint Communications, Inc. (hereinafter "FairPoint"), with this filing, is revising Section 32 of its Access Service tariff, F.C.C. NO. 1, to introduce Contract Tariff No. 50, which is being filed on one-day's notice pursuant to FairPoint receiving Phase I and Phase II Pricing Flexibility for Special Access and Dedicated Transport Services in the qualifying Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs).¹ This transmittal is being filed on September 28, 2011, and is scheduled to become effective September 29, 2011.

Customers subscribing to Contract Tariff No. 50 will receive certain discounts and credits on Special Access and Dedicated Transport Services in MSAs granted pricing flexibility by the FCC. The Contract Tariff sets forth the terms, conditions and the specific services for which the discounts and credits apply.

In order to take advantage of Contract Tariff No. 50, customers must subscribe to the Contract Tariff within 15 days of the tariff's effective date. The subscription period expires October 15, 2011.

This transmittal removes Contract Tariff No. 48 from section 32 of Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, which expired on May 31, 2010.
