**Re: Cablevision Lightpath, Inc. Tariff FCC No. 4, Revised Pages**

Dear Secretary Dortch:

Pursuant to the rules of the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”), attached are revised tariff pages filed by Cablevision Lightpath, Inc. (“Lightpath”) for its Tariff FCC No. 4 to implement the FCC’s recent order regarding voice over Internet protocol (“VoIP”) traffic exchanged with the public switched telephone network (“PSTN”).<sup>1</sup> In accordance with the FCC Order, this tariff filing adds language to Tariff FCC No. 4 regarding interstate toll VoIP-PSTN traffic.

This filing is not intended to suggest that the tariff did not apply to VoIP traffic exchanged prior to the effective date of the new tariff provision, does not constitute a waiver of any of Lightpath’s rights or remedies under the tariff provisions that were in effect prior to the effective date of the new tariff provision, and does not obviate any payment obligation of any third party under the tariff provisions that were in effect prior to the effective date of the new tariff provision.
