The Accompanying tariff material, issued by Telscape Communications, Inc. ("Telscape") (FRN: 0005040522), and bearing FCC Tariff No. 1, is being filed electronically on December 28, 2011, and is scheduled to become effective December 29, 2011. This filing is being sent to you in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

In this filing, Telscape, a competitive local exchange carrier ("CLEC"), revises its tariff to: (i) conform the tariff to formatting rules set forth in Part 61 of the Commission's rules that now apply to tariffs filed by CLECs; (ii) revise existing provisions and add new provisions to clarify the application of access charges, generally, and, also, specifically, to Toll VoIP traffic; (iii) delete obsolete material; (iv) revise certain existing rates to conform to applicable rate caps; and (v) establish rates for access services provided in various new locations. Supporting information is not required for this filing. This filing is made on not less than one day's notice.

In accordance with the Commission's fee filing requirements, a filing fee in the amount of \$845.00 has been paid by credit card and an electronic Form 159 has been submitted.


