A. Scope

Contract Tariff Option 51 (Option 51) provides special rates subject to the terms and conditions set forth herein on certain services offered by the Telephone Company pursuant to this Tariff. In consideration for special rates, and subject to the terms and conditions of the Contract Tariff, the Customer hereby agrees to abide by the requirements as set forth in further detail herein including agreeing to a limitation on the number of Grooms that the Telephone Company must perform on an annual basis, as set forth in C. following.

B. Eligibility

Customer must meet all of the criteria set forth in this Section B in order to receive the special rates, terms, and conditions under this Agreement as contained herein. All special rates, terms and conditions apply to DS-1 and DS-3 services provided pursuant to this tariff located in all MSA and non-MSA areas in the states of Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont that receive pricing flexibility in accordance with Applicable Law ("Pricing Flexibility Relief Areas").

- (1) During the twelve (12) month period prior to the commencement of the Term (as defined in Section 32.28.D. below), Customer and its affiliates must have collectively achieved a minimum DS-0 equivalent of **17,550,876** for all Qualifying Services (as defined in Section F.1 below) purchased by Customer or its affiliates from the Telephone Company. The Telephone Company will be deemed to have irrevocably waived any claim that Customer did not meet this requirement effective upon the Effective Date; and
- (2) As determined upon each anniversary of the Effective Date, Customer must pay the applicable Shortfall Penalty if the DS-0 Purchase Amount (as defined below) did not meet or exceed the applicable Minimum Annual DS-0 Equivalent Commitment ("MADEC") amount, as described in more detail in F(2) following; and
- (3) During the Term, the Customer and its affiliates must adhere to the Network Groom Restriction described in F(3) following; and
- (4) During the Term, the Customer must maintain an active subscription to FMS as contained in Section 7.2.16 of this tariff.

C. Subscription Period

Unless otherwise noted in a written agreement between Customer and the Telephone Company, Customer and its affiliates are eligible for the benefits as described herein if Customer submits a written authorization in a manner designated by the Telephone Company during the thirty (30) day period following the effective date.

Other than the FMS and Commitment Discount Plan (“CDP”) term plans, Customer may not concurrently subscribe to any other Tariff arrangement, contract tariff option, special service arrangement, or Individual Case Basis (“ICB”) arrangement offered by the Telephone Company and available to Customer either currently or at any time during the Term, which Tariff arrangement, contract tariff option, special service arrangement, or ICB provides a discount, credit, or other reduction in rates or terms based on achievement of revenue or volume targets/levels by Customer for the Qualifying Services. Upon The Telephone Company’ filing the Contract Tariff Option(s), The Telephone Company will be deemed to have irrevocably waived any claim that Customer and its affiliates did not meet the above requirement as of the Effective Date. No representation is made by The Telephone Company with respect to this matter as to any time period after the Effective Date.

D. Term

The term of this Agreement shall be two (2) years (“Initial Term”) commencing on the Effective Date of this Agreement, with two (2) optional one-year renewal terms (“Renewal Terms”) exercisable at the mutual agreement of Customer and The Telephone Company (the Initial Term and any Renewal Terms shall collectively be referred to as the “Term”). Such mutual agreement must be contained in writing signed by both parties prior to expiration of the Initial Term or Renewal Term, as applicable. The parties may discuss any future renewals of this Agreement (if any) at any time during the Term.

E. Serving Area

Subject to the restrictions set forth in this Section 32.28, the calculation of the DS-0 Purchase Amount (as defined below) shall be determined by Customer and its affiliates' purchases of Qualifying Services in all Metropolitan Statistical Areas ("MSAs") and non-MSA areas within the states of Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont (including, for the avoidance of doubt, both Pricing Flexibility Relief Areas ("Price Flex MSAs") and all other areas in the Telephone Company operating territory).

F. Terms and Conditions(1) Qualifying Services

- a. Description of Qualifying Services. Qualifying Services included in the calculation of the DS-0 Purchase Amount and contributing toward the MADEC (both defined below) will be comprised of the following Services:

The DS-0 equivalents for any Switched or Special Access Services as set forth in this tariff, as the same may be amended from time to time, and any Switched or Special Access Services provided under that Master Services Agreement entered March 8, 2007, and adopted between the parties effective March 31, 2008, as same may be amended from time to time (the "2008 MSA"), except as otherwise excluded pursuant to F(1)(c) following, which Services are billed by The Telephone Company during the Term ("Qualifying Services"); and

If The Telephone Company introduces a new SONET Special Access Service or enhancement or change to an existing SONET Special Access Service or FMS Services in its Tariffs or under the 2008 MSA, then such services shall be automatically included in Qualifying Services. All Qualifying Services in-service as of the Effective Date or ordered by Customer or its affiliates during the Term shall be included in the calculation of the DS-0 Purchase Amount.

All other services purchased by Customer from The Telephone Company or any affiliate of The Telephone Company and not described in this Section F(1)(a) and listed in the following Section F(1)(b) shall not be eligible for inclusion as Qualifying Services under this Agreement.

- d. Mergers and Acquisitions of Customer. If, after the Effective Date, Customer merges with another company, acquires a company or a portion of the business of another company, or is acquired in whole or in part by another company, the following terms and conditions will apply in addition to any other terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement and the Tariffs.
- i. The Customer may not combine or include any DS-0 equivalents from the merged, acquiring, or acquired company, or assets of such merged, acquiring, or acquired company in the definition of Qualifying Services or the DS-0 Purchase Amount.
 - ii. The calculation of the DS-0 Purchase Amount shall be based on Customer and affiliates circuits installed with The Telephone Company using the ACNAs supplied by the Customer without adding the DS-0 equivalents and/or ACNAs attributable to expansion of the Customer's purchase of Services from The Telephone Company through merger, transfer, assignment, or acquisition.
 - iii. The Telephone Company reserves the right to terminate this Agreement without liability if the Customer does not adhere to the provisions of this section.

- a. The DS-0 equivalents described in Sections F(1)(a) and F(1)(b) above will be the only DS-0 equivalent types included in calculation of the DS-0 Purchase Amount.
- b. Meeting the MADEC

If as of the end of the first year of the Initial Term, and the end of each subsequent year in the Initial Term and any Renewal Term, Customer's (and its affiliates, on a collective basis) DS-0 Purchase Amount (as defined below) equals or exceeds the MADEC that was in effect for such prior Term year (including, for the avoidance of doubt, taking into account any MADEC Reduction, as described below), Customer shall be entitled to keep all credits issued in accordance with Section G, below. If the DS-0 Purchase Amount is less than the MADEC that was in effect for such prior Term year (including, for the avoidance of doubt, taking into account any MADEC Reduction, as described below), Customer shall be entitled to keep all credits issued in accordance with Section G, below, and shall be required to pay a Shortfall Penalty as described in paragraph F(2)(f), below.

- i. The Customer's MADEC for the first year of the Term shall be 15,795,788 DS-0 equivalents of Qualifying Services.
- ii. At the end of the first year of the Initial Term and at the end of each subsequent year in the Initial Term and any Renewal Term, The Telephone Company and Customer will mutually agree in writing upon a revised MADEC that will be used for each such subsequent year of the Term. The revised MADEC will be calculated as follows. First, the Parties shall determine the DS-0 equivalent amount of all Qualifying Services that were invoiced to Customer and its affiliates using the ACNAs as of the anniversary of the Effective Date at the end of the then-completed Term year for the entirety of such Term year ("DS-0 Purchase Amount"). Next, the parties shall multiply the DS-0 Purchase Amount by ninety percent (90%) and the resulting amount will become Customer's new MADEC for the following year of the Term.

d. Business Downturn

- i. As used herein, the term "Business Downturn" shall mean a reduction in Customer or its affiliates' purchases of Qualifying Services caused by (i) loss of significant Customer business such that Customer's and its affiliates' collective DS-0 equivalent purchases of Qualifying Services falls below or is in danger of falling below the applicable MADEC, or (ii) a corporate divestiture, either (i) or (ii) of which significantly reduces the size or shape of Customer's or its affiliates' operations and the volume of network Services required by Customer or its affiliates with the result that Customer will be unable to meet the applicable MADEC for a given year of the Term notwithstanding Customer's best efforts to avoid such a shortfall (provided, however, that best efforts shall not require Customer to terminate service agreements with other telecommunications carriers which would cause Customer to incur termination liability charges or penalties). By way of illustration and not of limitation, the term "Business Downturn" shall not apply to a change in Customer's usage of The Telephone Company network services to the extent it is the result of a decision by Customer to reduce its overall use of telecommunications services, alter its telecommunications network architecture, or transfer portions of its telecommunications traffic to carriers other than The Telephone Company.
