By this amended transmittal letter, the accompanying tariff material, issued by North County Communications Corporation ("NCC") (FRN: 0005796693), and bearing FCC Tariff No. 2, is being filed electronically on January 6, 2012, and is scheduled to become effective January 15, 2012, the same date as the tariff material that was transmitted with original Transmittal No. 10. This filing is being sent to you in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. Additional issuing carriers include NCC's wholly owned subsidiaries: North County Communications Corporation of California (FRN 0019723428), North County Communications Corporation of Arizona (FRN 0019723469), North County Communications Corporation of Oregon (FRN 0019723436), and North County Communications Corporation of Illinois (FRN 0019723402).

By this filing, NCC, a competitive local exchange carrier ("CLEC") corrects the revisions submitted with original Transmittal No. 10 to: (i) correct the effective date shown on the revised tariff sheets (which previously showed an effective date of January 15, 2011 instead of 2012); and (ii) to correct the rates applicable to services provided in the Frontier SO area of Arizona (sheet 73), the Verizon CA area of California (sheet 74), and the Leaf Riv area of Illinois (sheet 74.3) (these rates were inadvertently increased above the tariff rates that were in effect on December 29, 2011 and have been revised down to the proper level). These corrections are made on not less than three days' notice.
