The filing modifies Section 6 (Switched Access Service) to introduce new provisions in compliance with the Commission's Inter-carrier Compensation rule changes in the Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, FCC 11-161, released November 18, 2011.

The proposed revisions to Section 6.1 specify that in the absence of a negotiated interconnection agreement between an interconnecting carrier and the Company addressing the treatment of Toll Voice over Internet Protocol – Public Switched Telephone Network (VoIP-PSTN) traffic, the rates and charges for Switched Access Service specified in Sections 12.3, 13.3, 14.2, 15.3, 16.2, 17.3, and 18.3 of the tariff will apply on all jurisdictionally interstate Toll VoIP –PSTN traffic.

This filing also revises Section 6.6 (Obligations of the Customer) to specify the call signaling information the customer is required to transmit on traffic handed off to the Company for termination to the Company's end user subscribers.

Also, this filing introduces a number of new definitions in Section 2.6 (Definitions) related to the proposed changes to the regulations in Section 6.

The filing also includes a correction to a tariff reference on page 16-2.

In compliance with the Commission's Rules, the transmittal, revised tariff, required Form 159 and \$845.00 filing fee are being transmitted electronically today via the Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System.
