The accompanying tariff material, issued on behalf of Great Lakes Comnet, Inc. and other Issuing Carriers bearing Tariff F.C.C. No. 20, Access Service, is being filed using the ETFS (Electronic Tariff Filing Service) in compliance with the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

The filing, to become effective January 14, 2012, consisting of tariff pages as indicated in the following check sheets:

This filing modifies Section 6 (Switched Access Service) to introduce new provisions in compliance with the Commission's Intercarrier Compensation rule changes that became effective December 29, 2011.<sup>1</sup>

The proposed revisions to Section 6.1 specify that in the absence of a negotiated interconnection agreement between an interconnecting carrier and the Telephone Company addressing the treatment of Toll Voice over Internet Protocol - Public Switched Telephone Network (VoIP-PSTN) traffic, the rates and charges for Switched Access Service specified in Section 17 of the tariff will apply on all jurisdictionally interstate Toll VoIP-PSTN traffic.

This filing also revises Section 6.3 (Obligations of the Customer) to specify the call signaling information the customer is required to transmit on traffic handed off to the Telephone Company for termination to the Telephone Company's end user subscribers.

Finally, this filing introduces a number of new abbreviations to the Explanation of Abbreviations on Pages 43 and 44, and changes to some existing definitions in Section 2.6 (Definitions) as well introduces a number of new definitions related to the proposed changes to the regulations in Section 6. The Company's FCC Registration Number is 0003-7262-70.
