Transmitted herewith, on behalf of Baraga Telephone Company, a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier, for filing in compliance with the Commission's Rules and Regulations, is its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1.

This filing modifies Section 6 (Switched Access Service) to introduce new provisions in compliance with the Commission's Intercarrier Compensation rule changes that became effective December 29, 2011.

The proposed revisions to Section 6.1 specify that in the absence of a negotiated interconnection agreement between an interconnecting carrier and the Telephone Company addressing the treatment of Toll Voice over Internet Protocol – Public Switched Telephone Network (VoIP-PSTN) traffic, the rates and charges for Switched Access Service specified in Section 17.2 of the tariff will apply on all jurisdictionally interstate Toll VoIP-PSTN traffic.

This filing also revises Section 6.3 (Obligations of the Customer) to specify the call signaling information the customer is required to transmit on traffic handed off to the Telephone Company for termination to the Telephone Company's end user subscribers.

Finally, this filing makes a number of changes to existing definitions in Section 2.6 (Definitions) as well as to introduce a number of new definitions related to the proposed changes to the regulations in Section 6.

The original letter of transmittal, along with F.C.C. Form 159 and the required \$845.00 filing fee are being delivered via overnight service to the U.S. Bank in St. Louis, Missouri.
