This Tariff sets forth the offerings, rates, terms and conditions applicable to Charter Fiberlink Companies in the provisioning of Switched Interstate Access Services ("Service") to Interexchange Carriers that furnish interstate services to Company's End Users in the following states: Alabama, California, Connecticut, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nevada, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Vermont, Virginia, Washington and Wisconsin.

The rates and regulations contained in this Tariff apply only to the Services furnished by Company and do not apply, unless otherwise specified, to the lines, facilities, or Services provided by any other Local Exchange Carrier or other Carrier for use in accessing the Services of the Company.

The Company shall not be deemed to have waived or impaired any right, power, requirement or option reserved by this Tariff (including, but not limited to, the right to demand exact compliance with every term and condition herein), by virtue of any custom or practice of the Company at variance with the terms hereof, or any failure, refusal or neglect of Company to exercise any right under this Tariff, or any waiver, forbearance, delay, failure or omission by the Company to exercise any right, power or option hereunder.

The provision of Services is subject to existing regulations and terms and conditions specified in this Tariff and may be revised, added to or supplemented by superseding Tariffs.

The Company reserves the right to offer its Customers a variety of Services as deemed appropriate by the Company.

7.1.1. End User Access Service**General Description**

End User Access Service provides for the use of an End User Common Line (EUCL) by an end user who obtains local exchange service from the Company. EUCL Charges and Federal Service Universal Fund fee (FUSF) Charges are assessed on End User Access Service.

The Company will be responsible for billing the End User customers the applicable End User Access Service charges.

The following items are not provided as part of End User Access Service:

1. Telephone number
2. Detail billing
3. Directory listings
4. Intercept arrangements

Rate Regulations

The EUCL Charge may be billed on a monthly basis to the End User customer of the Company for the associated local exchange service as set forth in **End User Common Line (EUCL)** following. (C)

The FUSF Charge may be billed on a monthly basis to the End User customer of the Company for the associated local exchange service based upon the local exchange service types as set forth following. (C)

End User Common Line (EUCL)

For residential local exchange service, the End User Common Line - Primary charge may apply each month to the primary line at the service location. If the End User has additional lines at that same service location, then the End User Common Line - Additional Line charge will be applied to each additional line each month. (C)

For business local exchange service, the End User Common Line charge may apply each month to each line at the service location. When local exchange service is provided as Primary Rate Interface (PRI) integrated services digital network (ISDN) and Session Initiated Protocol (SIP) trunking, the End User Common Line charge will apply as listed to each such local exchange service. (C)

The End User Common Line - Primary charge shall be reduced by 100% for qualifying Lifeline residential subscribers meeting Lifeline eligibility criteria established by their state commission.

INTERSTATE ACCESS SERVICE**7.1.4 Transport****Tandem Switched Transport**

Tandem-Switched Transport consists of the circuits used in common by multiple customers from the LEC's access tandem to the Company's end office. The Tandem-Switched Transport Rate includes four sub-elements: a Tandem-Switched Transport – Termination rate, a Tandem-Switched Transport rate, a Tandem Switch Rate and a Shared Multiplexing rate. The third sub-element, Tandem Switch Rate does not apply for Company's current Network Configuration. Sub-element descriptions and rates are provided below.

1. The Tandem-Switched Transport – Termination element is a usage rated, per minute rate to recover costs incurred at the ends of the transmissions links.
2. The Tandem-Switched Transport element is usage rated and distance-sensitive, i.e., a per access minute per airline mile rate. The rate recovers costs of the transmission facilities, including intermediate transmission circuit equipment, between the end-points of the circuit.
3. The Tandem Switched Transport - Shared Multiplexing Rate will be assessed on all minutes of use between the LEC's Access Tandem and the Company's end office. The Shared Multiplexing rate recovers multiplexing costs on the end office side of the Access tandem.

Rates are intended to mirror the ILEC's tariffed rates for the serving area. The rates below apply to calls originating from or terminating to end users in the service area of the listed ILEC.
