With this transmittal, Verizon is:

1. Eliminating the requirement that customers provide three months' notice when they discontinue Switched and Special Access DS3 Term Pricing Plans under Tariff FCC No. 1 and Special Access DS3 High Capacity service under Tariff FCC No. 14 and FCC No. 16. This revision will provide customers more freedom and aligns with existing notification requirements for Verizon's DS1 services and other tariffed DS3 services.
2. Increasing certain Special Access Pricing Flexibility rates in Tariff FCC Nos. 1, 11 and 14. Customer notification, as required, has been provided.
3. Revising the display of IntelliLight<sup>®</sup> Entrance Facilities (IEF) Pricing Flexibility rates in Tariff FCC No. 14 by separating Special Access rates from Switched Access rates.
4. Removing a footnote regarding a USOC that applies in the states of Pennsylvania and Virginia from certain rate pages under Tariff FCC No. 14 that do not include rates for those states.

Support material as described under Section 61.49 of Commission's rules is not required with this filing.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
