Dear Ms. Dortch,

AT&T Communications (AT&T) is a nondominant provider of interexchange services subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission. AT&T provides telecommunications services pursuant to AT&T Communications Tariff F.C.C. No. 28 (Access Service), AT&T Communications Tariff F.C.C. No. 29 (Consumer Telecommunications Service), and AT&T Communications Tariff F.C.C. No. 30 (Business Telecommunications Service). AT&T Communications will be merged into AT&T Corp. effective November 1, 2012. Thereafter AT&T Communications will be named AT&T Corp.

To effectuate this merger, AT&T proposes to cancel AT&T Communications Tariffs: F.C.C. No. 28, F.C.C. No. 29, and F.C.C. No. 30. On the same date, new tariffs will be issued as "AT&T Corp." The new tariffs will be named AT&T Corp. Tariff F.C.C. No. 2 (Access Service), AT&T Corp. Tariff F.C.C. No. 3 (Consumer Telecommunications Service), and AT&T Corp. Tariff F.C.C. No. 4 (Business Telecommunications Service). The name AT&T Corp. will appear on the title pages and in the upper left hand corner of each page of the new tariffs. The official name of the issuing carrier will be AT&T Corp, which will be shown on the "non-ILEC interexchange carrier" page of the new tariffs. These filings will be made in the same tariff transmittal on October 31, 2012 to be effective on November 1, 2012.

As discussed below, pursuant to §§ 61.151 through 61.153 of the Commission's rules, AT&T seeks special permission under which the Commission would grant a limited waiver, to the extent required, of §§ 61.54(c)(4), 61.54(i), and 61.74 of the rules in connection with AT&T's issuance of a new tariff

AT&T requests waiver of § 61.54(c)(4) and 61.54 (i) of the Commission's rules to permit AT&T to not use marginal coding or other notations to show text changes or moved material as would otherwise be required by these rules. All such changes will be non-substantive changes made to reflect organizational changes in the tariff.

AT&T requests a waiver of Section 61.74 of the Commission's rules to permit it to continue to reference in the new tariffs the same cross-references for which the Commission has previously granted a waiver or waivers of this rule, and which are not currently allowed by § 61.74. An example of a cross-reference is AT&T Business Telecommunications Service Tariff, Section 5.2.5 Non-Subscriber 1010288 Service Rates and Charges references AT&T Consumer Telecommunications Service Tariff, Section 8.3 for International rates.

AT&T proposes no new material or substantive changes to its Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, Tariff F.C.C. No. 3, Tariff F.C.C. No. 4, or the Informational Tariff as a result of the name change.

In accordance with 47 C.F.R. § 61.153, this Application letter and the appropriate illustrative tariff pages are being filed electronically today via the Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System, (ETFS). FCC Form 159 and the requisite \$845.00 filing fee have been transmitted via ETFS. These actions have been committed as the issued (filed) date as reflected above.
