The accompanying tariff material, issued by BellSouth Telecommunication, LLC (BellSouth) and bearing Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, is sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

The purpose of this letter, sent on behalf of BellSouth, is to file a revised Tariff Review Plan (TRP) to remove Credit Allowance for Service Interruptions. Such allowance provides a credit in certain circumstances and, as such, is not a service itself but simply a reimbursement amount for service not provided. By removing this Credit Allowance for Service Interruptions from the TRP, BellSouth's TRP will be consistent with those of the other AT&T operating companies.

In accordance with Section 61.14, this letter filing and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS) in compliance with the electronic filing procedures.
